Beginning on Wednesday, October 17 Zone V will offer three floral design courses. FA101 will be held on Wednesday, Oct. 17 - FA201 will be held on Thursday, Oct. 18 and FA301 will be held on Friday, Oct. 19th. You can register for one, two or three courses. The fee per class is \$125. This covers all materials, containers, lunch and nibbles.

FA101 is a beginning level floral design workshop for GCA members who have little or no flower arranging experience. This introductory design class is an opportunity for students to learn the basic skills necessary in flower arranging, including mechanics and what to put in your tool kit. It is the perfect class for those who would like to begin or learn more about flower arranging but are a little intimidated when taking classes with more experienced arrangers participating. This class is not open to members of the GCA Judging Program.

FA 201 is another workshop for beginners that provides the next level of contemporary designs to inspire creativity and interest in exhibiting in flower shows. This class is open to floral design Candidates and Prospectives in the GCA Judging Program. It is not open to Approved Floral Design judges.

FA301 is an intermediate workshop open to all arrangers to explore new design styles and the techniques needed to create them. It was created to foster new generations of flower show exhibitors and sharpen the knowledge and the hands-on experiences of floral design judges. Open to all levels of floral designers and members of the GCA Judging Program.

The registration fee for each class is \$125.00. The registration fee is non refundable after September 26, 2018 unless there is a wait list and your space can be filled. Please contact Mary Jo Strawbridge if you have to cancel your reservation. Each class is limited to 20 participants.

The registration fee covers all floral materials for two designs in the 101 and 201 classes. The 301 class will create one design. Fee for each class includes all containers, mechanics, the syllabus notebook, one sample issue of *By Design* magazine, morning coffee, tea, and a light lunch. Workshop leaders will discuss mechanics, techniques and resources and present two variations of the floral designs. Each participant will create their own arrangements with support from workshop leaders.
