

WEEDER AWARDS 2013

Cadwalader Trophy – Given by Emma W. Cadwalader and presented to that member of The Weeders who makes the most entries, prize-winning or not, in arrangement classes in the club flower shows during the year. In case of a tie, the most accumulated points will determine the winner.

Neophyte Bowl – Given by Mrs. Edgar Allan Poe and presented to that member of less than seven years standing who has won the most points in both arrangement and horticultural classes, not only in club shows but any outside shows. At least two entries must be in arrangement classes during the year. If this award is won a total of three times by the same member, a token will be presented to that member, who is no longer eligible for the award.

Horticulture Award – Presented to the Weeder accumulating the highest number of points for horticultural entries in club shows. A minimum of 25 points is required.
