- 3.) Best Bloom in your Garden, one stem, not to exceed 24."

To be judged as a par class *

- 4.) Any Potted Plant

Owner requirement – 3 months

- a. Flowering
 - i. Pot 6" and under
 - ii. Pot over 6"
- b. Foliage
 - i. Pot 6" and under
 - ii. Pot over 6"

5.) Challenge Plant Class

- a. Dahlia 'Sneezy'
 - i. Container
 - ii. Cut Stem
- b. Ipomopsis rubra 'Standing Cypress,' Cut Stem Distributed at the June 2023 meeting.
- c. Photo of your TOGO plant distributed at the June meeting. For educational purposes only. Not to be judged. Entry will earn ½ point for photography entry.

6.) Propagation Class

Include date and method of propagation.

To be judged as a Par Class*

- a. From any Weeder workshop
- b. Any other plant you propagated.
- c. A cut stem from a plant in your garden that you propagated (include any history you may have).

7.) Collection of at least 5 different cut specimens.

To be shown in exhibitor's own container. To be judged 75% for horticulture, 25% for artistic effect. Not to exceed 24" in width.

- a. Foliage only
- b. Mixed materials

8.) Collection of 3-5 stems of the same family but different genera

To be shown in exhibitor's own container.

9.) "Box Step"

A miniature arrangement not to exceed 18."

10.) "Twirling"

An arrangement not to exceed 24" in width.

11.) "Tango"

A team arrangement using two containers to be seen on all sides. Total width of display not to exceed 30".

Entrants should consist of one less experienced paired with a more experienced Weeder. To be judged as a pair.
